

What Happens Now?

Your physician has ordered a long-term Video Ambulatory EEG study as part of your health care diagnostic evaluation. Video monitoring allows the doctor who interprets the EEG data to visually monitor your movements. Some seizures and spells produce characteristic patterns of movement that are important to note in determining your diagnosis.

Here is what will happen next:

1. A technologist will come to your home to attach the electrodes and begin your EEG test.
2. A technologist will come back at the time specified by your doctor to remove the electrodes.
3. Your EEG test data will be delivered to your doctor for review in 48 to 72 hours.

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


How is the test performed?

- A technologist will arrive at your home to place electrodes on your scalp. These electrodes are held in place with a medical grade adhesive. The set up process will take between 1.5 and 3 hours.
- A technologist will return to your home at the end of your test to remove the electrodes and package the equipment.

Preparing for your test

- Make sure your hair is clean and dry. Do not apply conditioners, sprays or gels. Your hair must allow easy access to your scalp (no braids, pony-tails, wigs or weaves).
- Wear a shirt or blouse that buttons, zips or snaps so you can easily change clothes while wearing the electrodes.
- Have a straight back chair and table available so the technologist can set up your EEG.
- Your doctor may want you to stop taking certain medications before the test. DO NOT change or stop medications without first hearing from your doctor.
- You will not be able to bathe during your test so bathe beforehand, leaving enough time for your hair to dry.



Other Instructions

- Please put away any pets before the technologist arrives.
- Make sure the technologist has access to electric outlets where the camera tripods will be set up.

Answers to your questions

Are there any activities I won't be able to engage in?

You won't be able to shower, wash your hair or take a bath throughout the study. Additionally, avoid strenuous activities such as running, or brisk walking that will cause you to sweat.

Will my family members or spouse be videotaped?

If one of your family members happens to walk in front of the video cameras, they will be in the video briefly. However, the doctor is only interested in seeing you, the patient, when there are specific changes in your brain waves.

How do I know if this study is covered by insurance?

Typically, most insurance companies cover video ambulatory EEGs. Either your doctor's office or Global Neuro-Diagnostics will pre-authorize all testing with your insurance company prior to performing the test.
